2021 Referee Pay



- ▶ Different Pay Scale for IMSLA
- ▶ No increases from last year
- ▶ Want all full-time high school games to pay the same
 - ▶ Full-time: Junior Varsity = Varsity
 - ▶ Run-time mostly for tournaments
- ▶ Up-front Youth league payments agreed; allows reduced monthly delay to ref payments

2021 Spring Developments - IHSLL



- ▶ **Major schedule changes this year**
 - ▶ Varsity games prioritized on Wednesdays & Fridays
 - ▶ Stack JV & Varsity as much as possible, some Thursday overflow for JV teams w/o lighted field
 - ▶ Non-TV HS teams travelling to Boise may need to play on Saturday
- ▶ Still concerned about ref availability – North, East, & Moscow
- ▶ Moscow – no home games since no local refs
- ▶ Continue to provide Ref Cards for all HS games (including JV)
- ▶ Continue to emphasize enforcement for sportsmanship
- ▶ CONTINUE TO STRESS MULTIPLE MINUTE “SEVERE HIT” PENALTIES!
- ▶ No change from 2020 travel pay
